Uniform Requirements

As God continues to grow Unity Christian School, we continue to strive toward excellence in all we do. **Regardless of where uniforms are purchased, each student is responsible to adhere to the uniform requirements set forth in this brochure.**

This brochure has been compiled to effectively communicate the uniform standards for each age group of our student body. Below you will find the uniform policy taken from our Parent/Student Policy Manual found on our website www.unitychristianschool.org. Hopefully, you will find this brochure to be a helpful tool!

Uniform Policy

We are committed to excellence at Unity Christian School. We want this excellence to be seen in all aspects of our school, even the uniforms. We want our students to feel they are a part of something great, because they are. Just as athletic uniforms bring a sense of unity, pride and common goal to a team, so can school uniforms to a school.

Uniform Schedule

P.E. - Only UCS issued PE Uniforms should be worn on PE day.

Chapel wear should be worn on Wednesday.

Regular uniform should be worn on all other days.

Spirit Day - Provided no dress code violations exist, Friday dress will be Spirit Day. Students must wear a visible UCS approved shirt and blue jeans pants, Bermuda shorts in good condition, or UCS issue PE shorts. No holes in jeans.

Uniform Discipline

The school will follow the following procedures to correct students in violation of uniform policy:

First offense: Warning and parent/guardian will be contacted.

Second offense: Loss of Spirit/relaxed dress day and parent/guardian will be contacted.

Third offense: Detention and parent/guardian will be contacted.

Repeat uniform violations are unacceptable. Students with repeat uniform violations will be evaluated as needed by Administration.

Uniform Requirements for UCS

Regular Uniforms (3 days)

Boys: Grades K3-12th



- Polo shirts **with logo** (pale yellow, green, navy, burgundy, and white)
- **Only** Grades 9-12 may wear black polo shirts
- Navy or khaki pants or shorts (pleated or flat-front styles) no exterior pockets
- Belt must be worn every day; shirt must be tucked in at all times (K3 & K4 may wear shorts/pants with elastic waist band)
- Conservative athletic shoes (same as P.E.) or conservative school shoe (dark brown, tan, navy, or black)
- Shoes must be in good condition with closed toe and closed heel (Foot shoes are not allowed, such as Vibram Fivefinger shoes)

Girls: Grades K3-12th



- Polo shirts **with logo** (pale yellow, green, navy, burgundy, and white)
- **Only** Grades 9-12 may wear black polo shirts
- Navy or khaki pants, Capri's, or shorts (pleated or flat-front styles) no exterior pockets
- Navy or Khaki jumpers, skirt (knee length), or full-wrap skirt in styles pictured
- Belt must be worn whenever pants have loops; shirt must be tucked in at all times (K3 & K4 may wear shorts/pants with elastic waist band)
- Conservative athletic shoes (same as P.E.) or conservative school shoe (dark brown, tan, navy, or black) Shoes must be in good condition with closed toe and closed heel (Foot shoes are not allowed, such as Vibram Fivefinger shoes)

Chapel Uniforms



Boys: K3-8th Grades

- Light blue Oxford shirt with logo, buttoned & tucked in
- #80 plaid tie
- Khaki pants with belt (pleated or flat-front) no exterior pockets
- **Only K3-3rd**, khaki shorts (optional) no exterior pockets
- Conservative school shoe with back in dark brown, tan, navy, or black (closed toe and closed heel); **NO athletic shoes or boots**



Boys: 9th-12th Grades

- White Oxford shirt with logo, buttoned & tucked in
- #9 tie
- Navy pants with belt (pleated or flat-front) no exterior pockets
- Conservative school shoe with back in dark brown, tan, navy, or black (closed toe and closed heel); **NO athletic shoes or boots**



Girls: K3-2nd Grades

- White Peter Pan blouse with navy trim
- #80 plaid jumper (Style #194)
- Navy bike shorts (worn under jumper for modesty)
- Navy tights; Navy knee or crew socks
- Conservative school shoe with back in dark brown, tan, navy, or black (closed toe and closed heel); **NO athletic shoes or boots**



Girls: 3rd-8th Grades

- White Oxford blouse with crest logo, buttoned & tucked in
- #80 plaid skirt (Style #134) knee length
- Navy bike shorts (worn under skirt for modesty)
- #80 plaid cross tie (**Note: required for all Chapel dress, competition, and pictures**)
- Navy tights; Navy knee or crew socks
- Conservative school shoe with back in dark brown, tan, navy, or black (closed toe and closed heel); **NO athletic shoes or boots**



Girls: 9th-12th Grades

- White Oxford blouse with crest logo, buttoned & tucked in
- Navy skirt (Style #134 and #143) knee length
- Navy cross tie (**Note: required for all Chapel dress, competition, and pictures**)
- Navy tights; Navy knee or crew socks
- Conservative school shoe with back in dark brown, tan, navy, or black (closed toe and closed heel); **NO athletic shoes or boots**

P.E. Uniforms (P.E. day only)

Must Be Purchased from UCS



- **Navy** long or short sleeved Unity t-shirt
- **Navy** hooded sweatshirt
- **Maroon** shorts or sweatpants
- Conservative athletic shoes with no obvious brand names visible in good condition with backs
- White athletic socks

Accessories

Jackets, Sweaters, and Sweatshirts



- All jackets and sweaters worn on campus must be solid navy blue, black, brown, or grey (logo or embroidery optional)
- All sweatshirts must be Unity spirit wear (purchasable in UCS Development office)
- Boys: 2 rings (at most), 1 watch, 1 necklace
- Girls: 2 rings (at most), 1 watch, 1 set of earrings, 1 necklace, 1 bracelet
- Girls' hair accessories and book bags can be purchased from uniform provider (optional)
