**Governance**

A self-perpetuating Board of Directors leads Unity Christian School. The Board draws its membership from parents of the school and members of the community whose talents are needed to ensure the success of Unity Christian School.

**Missions Program**

We believe students, when properly equipped, can and will be a catalyst to reviving the church. Our Pre-Kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade students are taught about missions, missions' history and specific men and women who have been and are part of the global Christian movement. The study includes the people group the missionary worked/works among, the culture, the language and how the Gospel advances in that people. This not only prepares them for future work in missions; it prepares them to be better communicators of the Gospel in their own circles of influence. We encourage our



students, parents and teachers to be active in the local church and the church's mission work.

By the time our students graduate, they will have learned about at least 14 different men and women who changed the face of the globe through telling the story of the Gospel. The students will have learned how normal people with the same set of skills they have been given used their skills in the advancement of the Kingdom of Jesus, and our students will have a framework for seeing how they can engage a culture with the Good News of Jesus.
