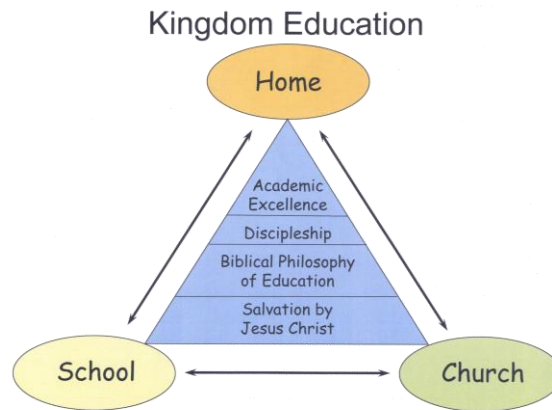




Kingdom Education
